

Tariff information

* Technical limitation: 45 000 minutes per month.

** On "Maqsad 50 PO" tariff plan, the subscription fee for the first month after activation is 45 000 UZS.

***The "Maqsad Max PO" tariff plan offers 2 TB of monthly internet traffic for additional resources at full speed. After the full-speed limit is reached, internet speed is reduced to a maximum of 64 kbps.

- Available for new connections and transfers to existing tariff plans of Postpaid system.
- The cost of changing the tariff from "Maqsad Lite PO", "Maqsad 50 PO", "Maqsad Pro PO" and "Maqsad Max PO" tariff plans to existing tariff plans of Postpaid system is 0 UZS.
- For individuals, switching from "Maqsad Lite PO", "Maqsad 50 PO", "Maqsad Pro PO" and "Maqsad Max PO" tariff plans to open corporate tariff plans is available by dialing the USSD command *929#.
- When changing the tariff within the "Maqsad PO" line and when switching from the "Maqsad PO" tariff line to other open corporate tariff plans, the remaining limits within the previous tariff are retained and added to the limits of the new tariff.
- Switching from open corporate tariff plans to "Maqsad Lite PO", "Maqsad 50 PO", "Maqsad Pro PO" and "Maqsad Max PO" tariff plans is not available.
- When the monthly limits within the tariff plans of "Maqsad PO" line are used up, calls and SMS are charged according to the cost for directions in excess of the limits under the terms of the tariff plan.

Detailed 5G terms and conditions

Conditions for additional internet traffic volume in the 5G network:

- The volume of Internet traffic in the 5G network issued within the tariff plan is available and consumed in 5G network and has the highest priority for consumption;
- When the 5G volume is fully used up, the Internet is charged in accordance with the current terms of the tariff plan;
- Internet traffic conditions do not apply to subscribers in roaming;
- Once the monthly internet traffic limit for all destinations under the tariff plan and additional internet packages is used up, internet access is suspended. However, internet traffic on 5G network will only be available for use if the internet requests generated require significant data transfer volumes and high internet speeds.
- When distributing the Internet through a smartphone or other device's access point, the assigned 5G Internet volume will only be available if the generated Internet requests require significant data transfer volumes and high Internet speeds.
- When connecting through proxy servers or VPN, Internet traffic will not be consumed from assigned 5G volume.

5G service terms:

- The service is provided free of charge.
- Connection of the service is available in statuses: active, idle.
- Due to the provision of additional 5G internet traffic, the 5G service is provided automatically on the "Maqsad 50 PO", "Maqsad Pro PO" and "Maqsad Max PO" tariffs.

Notes:

1 - Voice transmission and USSD requests are available in 5G network (when making a call, the network mode switches from 5G to 3G/2G or 4G with the VoLTE service active);

2 - 5G availability depends on many factors, including the mobile device's factory-installed software. Please note that some mobile device manufacturers are temporarily disabling 5G access at the software level to avoid difficulties with 5G usage due to limited network coverage.

Important!

By default, devices on 5G network can automatically switch back to more stable 4G LTE network, and therefore internet traffic will not be consumed according to 5G limits.

This can happen, for example, when:

- Internet queries do not require significant amounts of data transfer and high Internet speed;
- the subscriber leaves the 5G network coverage area or when the signal quality becomes insufficient for stable operation;

- In 5G mode, devices use the 4G LTE network to establish the initial connection and control (signaling), and then switch to 5G for data transfer.

At the same time, the 5G network icon may be displayed on the smartphone.

In these cases, Internet traffic consumption is considered correct due to the specific operation of 5G NSA technology, and no adjustments are envisaged by the Company.

Additional information

1. Write-off of monthly subscription fee and assignment of limits:

- The subscription fee for the tariff plans of the “Maqsad PO” line is debited on the first day of each calendar month.
- If you subscribe to “Maqsad Lite PO”, “Maqsad 50 PO”, “Maqsad Pro PO” and “Maqsad Max PO” tariff plans during the month, the subscription fee is debited on a scaled basis, and limits are assigned proportionally until the end of the calendar month, specifically only for the number of days remaining until the end of the month. This applies to new subscriptions and when exiting the financial lock.
- The provided minutes for calls and Internet within the tariff are available until the end of the calendar month and become unavailable in the new period.
- If the Client is in active status and the balance is less than the monthly subscription fee, the subscription fee for the plan is debited in full and the limits are assigned in full. However, the limits will become available for use after transitioning to active status.
- If the Client is inactive/has a negative balance, the subscription fee is not debited and no new tariff plan limits are assigned. The subscription fee for the tariff plan is debited immediately upon transition to Active status. Subscription fee debiting and limit assignment are scaled based on the number of days remaining until the end of the calendar month.
- When the monthly Internet traffic limit for the tariff plan is used up, the subscriber can connect additional Internet packages.

2. Blocking conditions:

- If the Client activates the “Temporary Blocking” service (for example, if the SIM card is lost), the subscription fee is not charged. If the number is switched to Active status in the same month in which it was blocked, the subscription fee is not charged. If the number is unblocked in subsequent months, the subscription fee will be charged only for the number of days remaining in the month, and the corresponding number of limits will be assigned.
- When you activate the “Number freeze” service, the subscription fee for the tariff is not charged.
- After disabling the “Number freeze” service, the subscription fee will be charged only for the number of days remaining in the month, and limits are assigned proportionally to the number of days remaining until the end of the month.
- Calls to infotainment services and international destinations do not consume minutes/MB/SMS provided within the limits under the tariff plan conditions.

3. Terms of “Restart” service

- The “Restart” service is activated via USSD *222#. Legal entities can activate the service by submitting a written request to the Company and through their Personal Account.

- The “Restart” service is available to subscribers in active status.
- The “Restart” service allows subscribers to independently activate their monthly subscription fee and receive monthly limits in accordance with the terms of the tariff plan.
- When connecting the service, the subscriber's account must have a subscription fee amount proportional to the number of days remaining in the current month.
- If the “Restart” service is successfully activated, the subscription fee for the tariff plan will be debited only for the number of days remaining in the month, and the corresponding number of limits will be assigned (scaled).
- On the day of connection and change to tariff plans of Postpaid system, activation of “Restart” service is unavailable.

4. Terms of dedicated internet traffic for social networks on “Maqsad PO” tariff line:

- The conditions for dedicated Internet traffic to social networks within the tariff plan do not apply to subscriber numbers in roaming;
- Dedicated internet traffic for social networks does not apply to downloading and updating Facebook, Instagram, Telegram, WhatsApp and YouTube mobile applications;
- When making an audio/video call through the Telegram, WhatsApp, Instagram and Facebook Messenger applications, Internet traffic will be used within the allocated general limit on the tariff plan or Internet packages, and not the Internet traffic allocated for social networks;
- In case of doubts or controversial situations regarding the fair use of communication services, “COSCOM” LLC reserves the right to terminate the Agreement or change the Client’s tariff plan.

Note:

Smartphones by default consume mobile data in the background: for system updates, app updates, synchronization of widget data (weather, calendar, etc.) and social networks, as well as for analytics counters (Google, google-analytics.com, googletagmanager.com, gstatic.com, stats.g.doubleclick.net). Internet traffic to these destinations is charged according to the Ucell Internet price under the terms of the tariff plan, or traffic is deducted from the balance of the existing Internet package provided for all destinations.

When internet access is blocked, to use payment system applications, the subscriber must disable data transfer mode for correct operation in offline mode.

Please note:

- To avoid misunderstandings, we recommend you to check the tariff plan's limits before using them. Before assigning minute, text, and MB limits, charges are applied based on the cost of destinations exceeding the limits, as per the tariff plan terms.
- Calls to infotainment services and international destinations do not consume the minutes provided under the tariff plan.
- The limits provided within the tariff plan are not available for subscribers in roaming.
