1. The tariff plan is available for new connections and upgrades from lower tariffs.
2. Write-off of monthly subscription fee and assignment of limits:
  - The date of debiting the monthly subscription fee in a monthly period is the date of connection/transition of the subscriber to the tariff plan.
  - When you connect to a new tariff plan/switch to a new one, the monthly subscription fee and limits are written off/assigned in full (not scaled) if there is a sufficient amount on the balance.
  - If there are insufficient funds or a negative balance to write off the monthly subscription fee for the tariff, the write-off does not occur, the included traffic limits are not assigned, the subscriber's number balance is not written off as debt.
  - The subscription fee is charged once per month, starting from the date of successful debiting of the monthly subscription fee within the tariff plan. The date of debiting the next monthly subscription fee is the date of the last successful debit of the subscription fee within the tariff plan.
  - The next monthly subscription fee and allocation of limits within the tariff plan are applied on the same day and at the same time when the subscriber topped up their balance in the previous month (for example, if the subscription fee was charged on May 15 at 12:00, the next subscription fee will be charged on the same day of the following month at 12:00). To ensure the full monthly subscription fee is charged, the subscriber must have a sufficient balance on their account.
  - The subscription fee is charged once per month, starting from the date of successful debiting of the monthly subscription fee within the tariff plan. The date of debiting the next monthly subscription fee is the date of the last successful debit of the subscription fee within the tariff plan (if the subscription fee debit date was set for the 31st, and the following month has 30/29/28 days, then the next subscription fee will be charged on the 30th, or on the 28th/29th of February. If the subscription fee within the tariff plan is paid on time (the number remains continuously active), the next subscription fee will be charged on the 31st).
  - If there are insufficient funds in the account balance to cover the monthly subscription fee at the time the fee is debited, the subscriber's number will be blocked. The subscription fee will not be debited until there are sufficient funds in the account balance to cover the full amount.
  - The monthly subscription fee will be debited immediately upon replenishment of the balance with a sufficient amount to cover the full subscription fee. After the subscription fee is debited, the subscriber number will become active and the limits set by the tariff plan will be applied. Subsequently, the subscription fee will be debited according to the subscriber's new monthly period, i.e., within one month from the date of the last successful subscription fee debit under the tariff.

### **3. Blocking conditions:**

- The number is blocked if the balance is positive, if there are insufficient funds on the balance at the time of debiting the monthly subscription fee for the tariff plan, or if the balance is negative, if there are corresponding additional services;
  - When in a blocked status, changing your tariff plan is unavailable;
- If the subscriber's balance has a sufficient amount to cover the subscription fee for another available tariff plan, the tariff can be changed using all available methods.
- In the blocked status, the subscriber has access to the remaining limits of previously purchased monthly Internet packages until their expiration (if there is a balance).
  - The general conditions for staying in blocked status can be found here

4. Monthly limits within the tariff plan are assigned only after the monthly subscription fee for the current period has been successfully debited. Any remaining monthly limits assigned in the current period do not carry over to the next period.

- To avoid any misunderstandings, we recommend you to top up your balance in advance with a sufficient amount to cover the full subscription fee and check the assigned limits for your tariff plan using Ucell mobile app or USSD request \*100#.

- When the monthly limits within the tariff plan are used up, calls are charged according to the cost for the directions exceeding the limits under the terms of the tariff plan.

- Once the monthly limit is used up, to continue using minutes, the subscriber must:

- Update tariff limits (activate “Restart” service);
- Change tariff plan

The subscriber can also independently activate the option “Connect mobile Internet at the cost of 1 MB over the limit” using the USSD request \*727#.

Please note:

- When switching to other available tariff plans, previously assigned limits for the previous tariff plan are reset to zero.

- To avoid misunderstandings, before using your tariff plan limits, we recommend you to check your tariff plan limit assignment using the USSD request \*100# or through Ucell mobile app. Before limits are assigned, charges are applied based on the cost of destinations over the limits, as per the tariff plan terms.

5. Calls to infotainment services and international destinations do not consume the minutes provided under the terms of the tariff plan.

6. Calls to information and reference services of JSC “Uzbektelecom”, information and entertainment services of content providers and international destinations do not consume the minutes provided under the terms of tariff plans.

6.1 Services of JSC «Uzbektelecom». Tariffing is made for the connection, according to the cost specified in the table via [https://ucell.uz/ru/services/jsc\\_uzbektelecom](https://ucell.uz/ru/services/jsc_uzbektelecom) (if there are limits, the limits are not used. The write-off will be made from the subscriber's balance according to the cost in excess of the limit under the terms of the tariff plan). The cost of a minute of a call is charged according to your tariff plan per minute, starting from the 1st second after the connection, rounded up to a full minute. 7. The limits provided under tariff plans are not available for subscribers in roaming.

8. Subscribers of “Ovoz Plus” tariff plan have access to the following services: “New Monthly internet packages”, “Unlimited Ucell internet packages in the Underground” (only the “Unlimited for 30 days” package), “Night internet packages”, “Try 4G at Night”, “TAS-IX internet packages”, “MEGA BOOM Internet”, the “Al Chiroq” promotion, “Traffic+” , “Daily SMS packages.

9. Subscribers of “Ovoz Plus” tariff plan do not have access to the following: Daily and weekly internet packages, , “Convenient minutes”, “Convenient within network”, “Convenient within Uzbekistan”, Monthly 4G internet packages (and similar packages within the “We Appreciate You” loyalty program), “Number freeze”, “Night Internet”, “Ordered package”, “Hourly Internet”, and the “Maximum Access” and “Megabytes are returning” services, the “We Appreciate You!” loyalty program, and the “U+” loyalty program.

10. Monthly limits received within the tariff plan are not carried over to the next month after changing the tariff plan.

11. To avoid fraudulent connections, the Company reserves the right to terminate the Agreement with the subscriber if the outgoing traffic within 30 days after connection is close to 0.

Terms of “Restart” service

1. The “Restart” service is activated using a mobile application or USSD \*222#.

2. The “Restart” service is available to subscribers in active status.

3. The “Restart” service allows subscribers to independently activate their monthly subscription fee and receive monthly limits according to the terms of their tariff plan. After activating “Restart” service, the subscriber's monthly period is updated based on the date of their last successful activation of this service.

4. After activating “Restart” service, the full monthly subscription fee is debited from the subscriber's balance, and the full monthly limits are assigned within the subscriber's tariff plan. The subscriber's monthly subscription fee is then debited according to the subscriber's new monthly period.
5. To activate the service, the subscriber's balance must be sufficient to cover the full subscription fee. Once “Restart” service is activated, the subscription fee will be debited and the full tariff limits will be assigned.
6. The remaining limits previously assigned within the tariff plan are reset to zero upon successful activation of “Restart” service.
7. On the day of debiting the monthly subscription fee for the tariff plan, the “Restart” service is not available for activation.
8. You can use “Restart” service only once a day (from the beginning of the current day, from 00:00 to 23:59).
